

1 - wall shelf




wall mounting assembly

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. These instructions are for drywall mounting only.

- A)** Determine the location for **wall shelf**. Using a level, position wall shelf and mark 3 hole positions on the wall.
- B)** Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 3 **plastic anchors** into holes. Gently tap **plastic anchors** into the wall until the flange of the anchor is flush.
- C)** Align holes of **wall shelf** with corresponding anchors in wall. Insert 1 **screw** through wall shelf and into each **plastic anchor** as shown, using a screwdriver. Installation is now complete.

NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.



cleaning and care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

weight limitations

The maximum load is 37lbs, evenly distributed.
