





1 - tabletop




1 - base

NOTE: Do not over tighten the bolts



A. With the assistance of another adult, place **tabletop** upside down on a clean, padded surface. Fit **base** into tabletop as shown. B. Attach base to tabletop with 8 **hex bolts**, 8 **rubber washers**, 16 **flat washers** and 8 **hex nuts**. Secure hex bolts and hex nuts with 2 **hex wrenches**, turning 1 clockwise and 1 counter-clockwise as shown. Do not over tighten the bolts. With the assistance of another adult, position unit upright. Assembly is now complete.

cleaning & care

Treat the surface on a regular basis with a transparent stone floor wax. Cement is sensitive to all kind of spills and extremely porous, so remove spills immediately with a dry cloth. Use coasters to protect from heat and water. If used outdoors, keep covered when not in use to protect against staining from pollution and rain. Store the table inside during the winter in a cool, dry place. Be aware that color and natural veining will vary with each piece. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp cloth. Do not use abrasives or cleaners with citric acid. Please protect the surface when using markers. Staining may occur when oils or liquids with artificial coloring come in contact directly with the porous surface.

caution

Exposure to direct sunlight may alter the color.
