






1 - key hook assembly

level (not included)




power drill

(We recommend the use of hand tools instead of power tools)

wall mounting assembly

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.

A. Determine final location of **key hook assembly** and mark holes on wall. Using a **level**, adjust the **key hook assembly** until it is level. Drill a hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 2 **plastic anchors** into holes and gently tap with a hammer until each is flush with surface of the wall.

B. Insert 2 **screws** through the **key hook assembly** and into the plastic anchors in the wall. Secure, but do not over tighten, screws with a Phillips head screwdriver.

Wall mounting is now complete.

cleaning & care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

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
