




1 - 13 watt max CFL bulb



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. These instructions are for drywall mounting only. **If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.**


We recommend installation of this lamp be performed by a licensed electrician.

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to override this safety feature.

cleaning & care


Dust surfaces with a dry soft cloth. Do not use polishes or cleaners on the lamp.


Determine the location for the wall sconce. Using a **level**, position **wall template** and mark 2 hole positions on the wall. Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 2 **wall anchors** into holes. Gently tap **wall anchors** into the wall until the flange of the anchor is flush.

Insert 1 **screw** into each **wall anchor** as shown. Using a **Phillips head screwdriver**, fasten screw into wall, leaving approximately 1/16" (2mm) of the screw head protruding from the wall.

A. Fit holes of lamp fixture mounting plate onto screw heads. To secure, gently push down on mounting plate until screw heads lock into position. Make sure screw heads securely engage mounting plate.

B. Insert **bulb** into fixture. **DO NOT EXCEED SPECIFIED WATTAGE.**

Installation is now complete.
