






tools required

(for pilot holes only)




level

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

components

1 - bike rack assembly



wall mounting assembly


NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.

A) Determine the final location of unit. Using a level, position **bike rack assembly** onto wall until it is **level**. Mark 3 hole positions on the wall.

B) Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 3 **plastic anchors** into holes. Using a screwdriver, fasten **plastic anchors** into the wall until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.

C) Insert 3 **screws** through **bike rack assembly** and into **plastic anchors** in the wall as shown, using a screwdriver.

Wall mounting is now complete.



cleaning & care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

Note: This item is able to support up to a total of 40 lbs evenly distributed.
