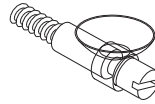

large - 24 shelf pins

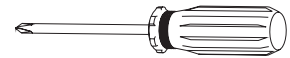


4 - adjustable feet

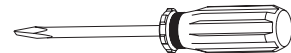

tools required

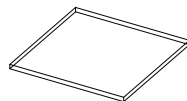
Phillips head screwdriver



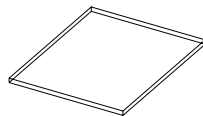
flathead screwdriver



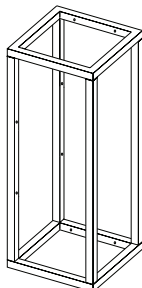
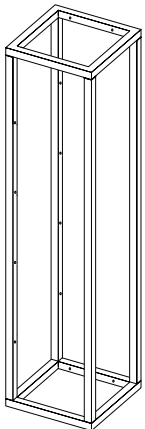

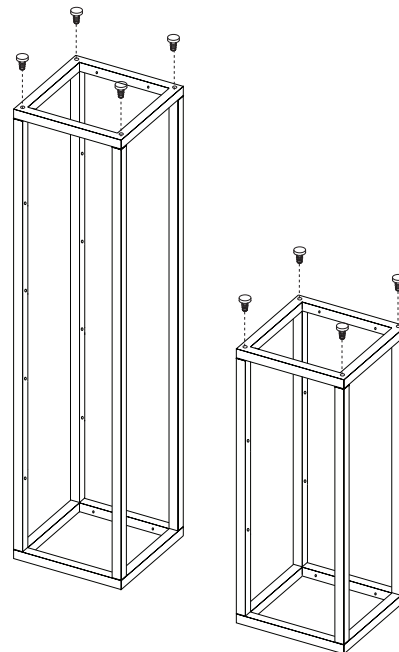
2 - top/bottom glass shelves



small - 2 glass shelves
large - 4 glass shelves



1 - large or small frame



With the assistance of another adult, position **large or small frame** upside down as shown. Attach 4 **adjustable feet** into frame as shown. Turn feet clockwise to secure.

Make sure cup on shelf pin faces upwards

2 Position assembled unit upright. Place **frame** upright on a padded surface as shown. Attach **24 shelf pins** into **large frame** and **16 shelf pins** into **small frame** as shown. Secure each shelf pin with a **flathead screwdriver**.

3 Carefully place the smaller square **top/bottom glass shelf** on the shelf pins at the top and bottom of the frame as shown. Make sure shelves are securely supported by shelf pin. Place each **glass shelf** onto the remaining shelf pins. Assembly is now complete.

optional wall attachment

(for large tower only)

2 - bolts 2 - screws 2 - drywall anchors

4 - metal brackets 2 - wall straps

These instructions are for drywall mounting only. For safe installation it is essential to use hardware appropriate for your wall type. Mount to wood wall studs whenever possible. If you are unsure of what type of fasteners to use, consult your local hardware store or a qualified professional. This product is only a deterrent, it is not a substitute for proper adult supervision.

A. Attach **2 metal brackets** to the top of the assembled unit with **2 bolts**.

B. With the assistance of another adult, place the unit in desired location against the wall. Mark the location of the hole in the bracket on the wall. Move the unit out of the workspace.

C. Drill holes slightly smaller in diameter than the drywall anchors. Insert the **drywall anchors** into the holes until they are flush to the wall.

D. Insert **1 screws** through each metal bracket and into the drywall anchor. Secure, but do not over tighten with a **Phillips head screwdriver**.

E. Place the bookcase back into position against the wall and thread the **wall strap** through both brackets and pull until tight.

cleaning & care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth.
