components

1 - wall shelf

tools required

phillips head screwdriver level power drill (for pilot holes only)

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

wall mounting assembly

NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.

A. Determine final location of **wall shelf**. If possible, make sure at least 1 hole is aligned with a wall stud. Using a level, adjust wall shelf until it is level. Mark holes on wall. Set wall shelf aside.

B. If a wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 2 **plastic anchors** into the holes. Gently tap each anchor until the head is flush to the wall surface.

C. Insert 2 **screws** through **wall shelf** and into the anchors in the wall as shown. Wall mounting is now complete.

NOTE: Do not over tighten the screws

cleaning & care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
