




tools required



cleaning and care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

For added safety and stability, it is recommended that the wall mounting hardware be installed. For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. **The following instructions are for drywall mounting only.**

NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.

- A) Determine the final location of unit. Mark position on the wall for each **mounting bracket**.
 - B) Drill a hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Gently tap each **plastic anchor** until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
 - C) Attach 2 **mounting brackets** to the wall by inserting 2 **screws** through each mounting bracket and into the wall anchor. Secure, but do not overtighten each screw with **phillips head screwdriver**.
 - D) Place bookcase back into final location. Lace one end of each **wall strap** around bookcase frame, and into the other end of the strap. Pull each strap tightly until secure.
 - E) Adjust pre-installed **levelers** as necessary to compensate for uneven floors.
- Wall mounting is now complete.
