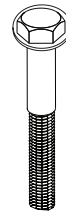

Note: 2 people are recommended to safely assemble this product.

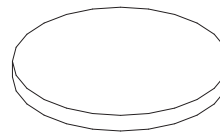

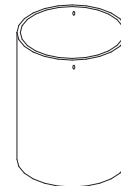
4 - bolts

1 - tabletop

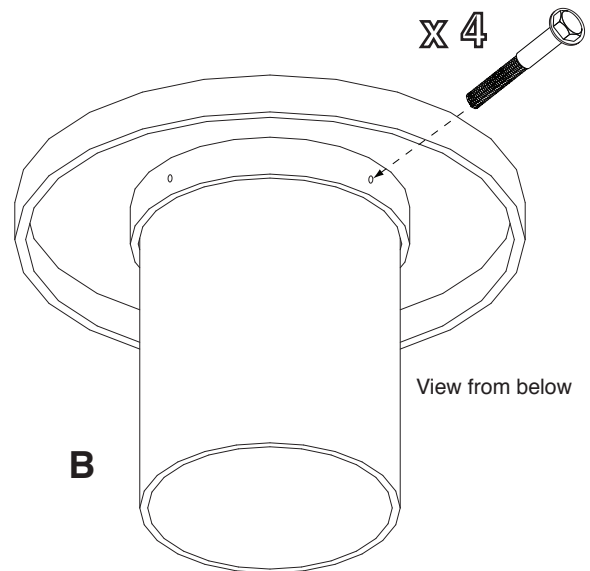
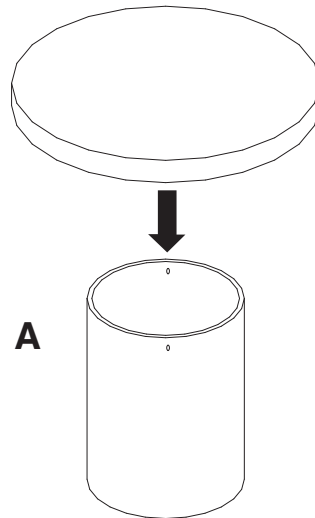


1 - base

A. With assistance of another adult, fit **tabletop** onto **base** as shown. Make sure corresponding holes of the tabletop and base align.

B. Insert **4 bolts** into the corresponding holes of assembly. Firmly push on each bolt until the head is flush with the surface.

Assembly is now complete.

**cleaning and care**

Treat the surface on a regular basis with a transparent stone floor wax. Cement is sensitive to all kind of spills and extremely porous, so remove spills immediately with a dry cloth. Use coasters to protect from heat and water. If used outdoors, keep covered when not in use to protect against staining from pollution and rain. Store the table inside during the winter in a cool, dry place. Be aware that color and natural veining will vary with each piece. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp cloth. Do not use abrasives or cleaners with citric acid. Please protect the surface when using markers. Staining may occur when oils or liquids with artificial coloring come in contact directly with the porous surface. **CAUTION:** Exposure to direct sunlight may alter the color.
