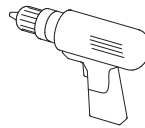

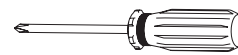

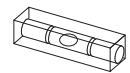
## tools required

1 - house number

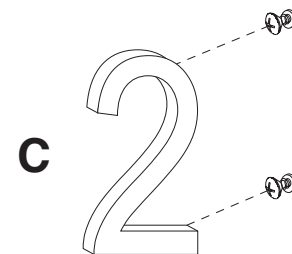
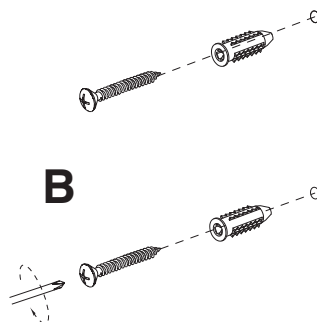
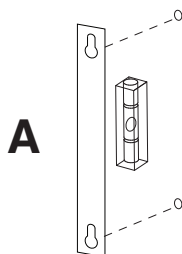


1 - wall template

## wall mounting assembly

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible.

- Determine the location for the **house number**. Using a **level**, position **wall template** and mark 2 hole positions on the wall.
- Drill pilot holes in the wall stud. If a wall stud is not available, drill holes in the wall slightly smaller in diameter than the anchors. Gently tap **plastic anchors** into holes until the flange of each anchor is flush to the wall. Insert 1 **screw** into each **plastic anchor** as shown, using a **screwdriver**. Leave approximately 1/4" of the screw head protruding from the wall.
- Align keyholes on back of **house number** with screws and fit securely onto screw heads. Make sure unit is securely supported by both screws. Installation is now complete.



## cleaning and care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
