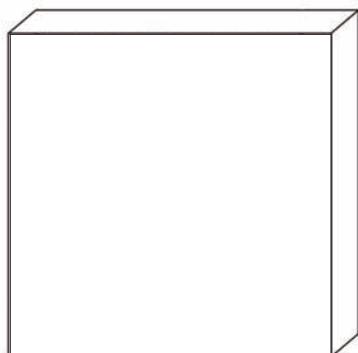

2 - wall screws

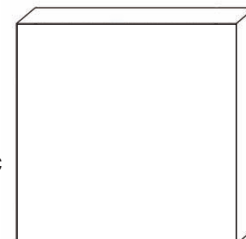


2 - plastic anchors

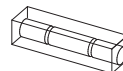

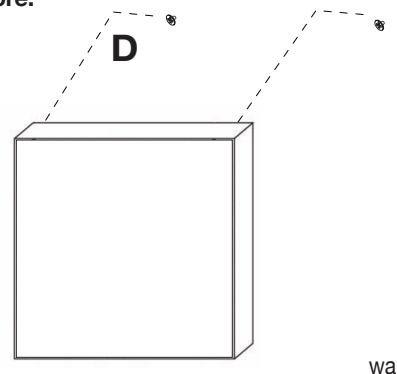
wall mounting assembly

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. The following instructions are for drywall mounting only:

- A. Determine the final location of the unit. Place **wall template** into desired position. If possible, make sure at least 1 hole is aligned with a wall stud. Using a **level**, adjust the wall template until it is level and tape to the wall.
- B. Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If a wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Remove **wall template**.
- C. Insert 2 **plastic anchors** into the holes and gently tap until each anchor head is flush to the wall surface.
- D. Insert 2 **wall screws** through the **plastic anchors** and into the anchors in the wall, leaving 1/4" of the screw protruding from the wall.
- D. Rest **magnetic dry erase board** onto corresponding wall screws as shown. Make sure the magnetic dry erase board is securely supported by each screw as shown. Wall mounting is now complete.



NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.



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
