

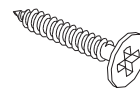

### cleaning & care

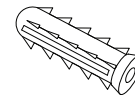
Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

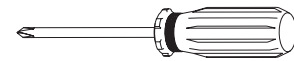

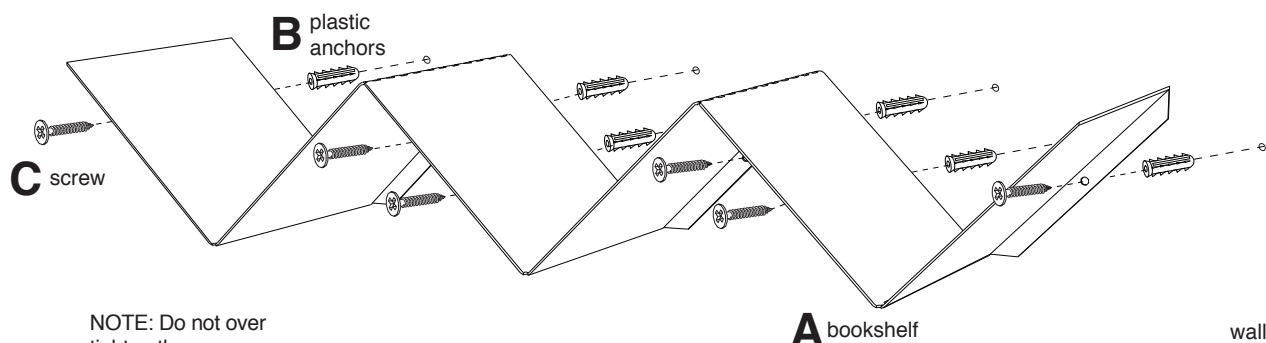
(We recommend the use of hand tools instead of power tools)

## wall mounting assembly

**NOTE: If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.**

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. These instructions are for drywall mounting only.

- A)** Determine the final location of unit. Using a level, position **bookshelf** onto wall until it is **level**. Mark 6 hole positions on the wall.
- B)** Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert **6 plastic anchors** into holes. Gently tap **plastic anchors** until the flange of the anchor is flush with the wall.
- C)** Insert **6 screws** through **bookshelf** and into **plastic anchors** in the wall as shown, using a **phillips head screwdriver**.  
 Installation is now complete.



NOTE: Do not over tighten the screws
