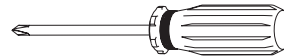

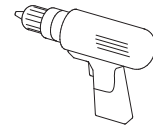

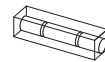

Phillips head screwdriver

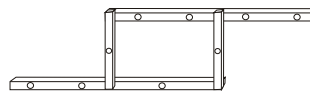

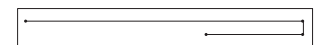

## wall mounting assembly

For safe mounting, it is essential to use wall anchors appropriate to your wall type (i.e. plaster, drywall, concrete, etc.). Mount to wood studs whenever possible. These instructions are for drywall mounting only.

- A)** Determine the location and orientation (vertical or horizontal) of **coat rack**. Using a **level**, tape **wall template** and mark hole positions on the wall. Remove wall template. Drill a pilot hole in the wall stud. If the wall stud is not available, drill a hole in the wall that is slightly smaller in diameter than the anchor. Insert 2 **plastic anchors** into holes. Gently tap **plastic anchors** into the wall until the flange of the anchor is flush.
- B)** Using a screwdriver, insert 2 **screws** into **plastic anchor** in the wall as shown. Do not fully insert screws, leave 1/4" of each screw exposed from anchors.
- C)** Fit keyholes of **coat rack** into corresponding **screws** in wall. Make sure coat rack is securely supported. Installation is now complete.

## cleaning and care

Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

**NOTE:** If you are unsure about your wall type or what mounting method you should use, consult a qualified professional or your local hardware store.
